

Wisconsin Lions Camp Staff Alumni Fall Retreat Weekend

The alumni reunion weekend is designed to provide a resort weekend for individual alumni and families of alumni of the Lions Camp. Parents or guardians assume total responsibility for their children while at camp. The Lions Camp provides program activities, lodging, and meals. Extended family members, such as grandparents, sisters, brothers, nieces and nephews may attend with your family and share a cabin with you.

Dates:

August 31 – September 3, 2018 (lodging availability limited on a first-come, first-serve basis) Arrival is on Friday, August 31 between 6:00 - 10:00 PM and departure is on Monday September 3 by 1:00 PM.

Costs:

Weekend rates for persons staying Friday – Monday:

These costs are for each family member based on age.

\$200.00 (ages 13 and older) \$140.00 (ages 6-12) \$100.00 (ages 1-5)

Families will be assigned to own cabins. Individual alumni will be assigned to stay with other individual alumni.

Day Rates for persons only joining us for the day (rates include two meals):

Per Day: \$35 per adult, \$30 per youth ages 1-12. If the day includes a night's stay, the rates are \$60 per adult, and \$50 per youth ages 1-12.

Discounts:

Alumni Association Member:

If you include your alumni membership payment with this application, you are entitled to a 15% discount off of the total cost of the stay (minus the alumni membership payment).

Sharing a cabin with another family:

If you stay with another family within a cabin, you can receive a \$50 refund after the weekend is completed. Please pay the full amount up front.

Lodging:

Housing facilities are such that each family is provided a cabin for the weekend stay. Individual alumni will be housed together. Showers and bathrooms are located in the lodges where your family stays. All bedding is provided, **but bring your own towels and personal items.**

Meals:

- Saturday- Breakfast, Lunch, Supper
- Sunday- Breakfast, Lunch, Supper
- Monday – Brunch
- Snacks provided each evening

Cancellations:

A full refund is provided if cancellation occurs 2 weeks or more prior to the session. The camp may cancel the weekend due to inclement weather or lack of attendance and will provide full refunds.

Property:

The Lions Camp is not responsible for any loss or damage to personal property of the participants.

Insurance:

The Lions Camp does not provide any health and accident insurance for the participants. Participants must carry their own insurance or be prepared to pay for cost of any medical services required while at the Camp.

Medical care:

The Lions Camp does not provide nursing services or other medical care in this program. Emergency medical care is available in Stevens Point.

Equipment:

Program equipment such as boats, sand toys and nature equipment are all provided by the Camp. Those wishing to fish are encouraged to bring their own fishing equipment and bait (no minnows please). All Wisconsin fishing rules apply to this lake and we encourage catch-and-release.

Activities:

The camp will have a tentative schedule laid out for you of activities we will be leading and what times they will take place. Your family can choose to join us, or if you prefer to do something else with the family, that's fine too. Please note that **all children under 18 must be supervised by a parent or guardian on all activities**. We invite alumni to lead activities such as sport competitions, campfire songs and storytelling! There will be an opportunity to sign up to lead activities during registration.

What to bring?

Alumni are encouraged to bring photo albums from when you worked at Camp. Families may also want to bring along a board game or two for indoor time. If your family would like to take up some fishing, bring your own fishing equipment and bait (no minnows please). Personal items to bring include: towels, toiletry items, weather-appropriate clothing, and don't forget the camera to capture all the fun!

Emergency phone calls to you should be directed to the camp phone at 715-677-4969 during business hours. If after hours, the emergency camp phone number is 715-572-8179. Most cell phones can get service here and there is a limited wireless connections on Camp in the main buildings.
